For example, I was referring to Raja, not Robin. E. Direct quotes are marked by a comma. For example, she said, I'm sorry. 2) SEMICOLON (;) The comma is a stronger pause than a comma. It is used to highlight the close relationship between one sentence and another. For example, today we love what we hate tomorrow; today we look for what we avoid tomorrow; today we wish what we fear tomorrow. 3) COLON (:) The colon is used to show that something is to follow. For example, the main parts of the verb in English: present time, past time and past participation. 4) DASH (-) dash is used to make a sharp stop or change of thought. For example, if my husband was alive, but why mourn the past? He-you can't believe it failed. 5) WARNING (!) exclamation point is used after interjections and after phrases and sentences expressing sudden emotions or desire. For example, alas! Oh dear! 6) INVERTED COMMAS () Inverted commas are used to apply exact speaker words, or quotes. For example, I would rather die, he exclaimed, than join the oppressors of my country. 7) WARNING (?) The question mark is used, not Full Stop, after a direct question. For example, have you finished writing? 8) FULL STOP (.) Full stop is used to mark the end of a declarative or imperative offer.
